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Subject Input for the discussion on adequacy in the Pentalateral region

Dear members of the Pentalateral Energy Forum,

We have appreciated very much the political declaration of the Pentalateral Energy Forum last year, extending the work on generation adequacy assessment of the forum. This work is urgently needed given the issues with generation adequacy of different member states of the Pentalateral Energy Forum.

So far market parties have not been included in the process, but we believe that our input improves the result of the discussion. The adequacy assessment will relate specifically to the discussions on Capacity markets that currently take place.

To do so we have drafted a discussion paper as input (see attached paper). This paper is building upon our input for last years' political declaration and gives the precondition for a joint CWE capacity market, building upon a joint assessment of generation adequacy in the region. This should be regarded as input for an ideal regional energy and capacity market design design.

We would be very happy to explain this more in detail on the next SG 2 meeting on 25 February 2014.
